I N D I C T M E N T

The Grand Jury charges:

From on or about September 24, 2010 through on or about September 27, 2010, the defendant, **CRAIG ANDREW ARMSTRONG**, knowingly traveled in interstate commerce from Kentucky to Bernalillo County, in the District of New Mexico, for the purpose of engaging in illicit sexual conduct with another person, that being a sexual act, as defined in 18 U.S.C. § 2246, with a person whom he believed to be between the ages of 12 and 16, such sexual act would have been in violation of 18 U.S.C., Chapter 109A, had the sexual act occurred in the special maritime and territorial jurisdiction of the United States, to wit: sexual abuse of a minor in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 2243(a).

In violation of 18 U.S.C. § 2423(b) and (f).
