INDICTMENT

The Grand Jury charges:

Count 1

On or about September 15, 2009, in Bernalillo County, in the District of New Mexico, the defendant, **HENRY JAGER** did knowingly possess a Hewlett Packard Laptop Computer, Serial Number CNF5391VVG, with Toshiba 80 GB Internal Hard Disk Drive, Serial Number 95GU4921S, containing any visual depiction that had been shipped and transported in interstate and foreign commerce, and which was produced using materials which had been shipped and transported in interstate and foreign commerce, by any means, including by computer, the production of which involved the use of a minor engaging in sexually explicit conduct and is of such conduct.

In violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 2252(a)(4)(B), 2252(b)(2), and 2256.

Count 2

On or about September 15, 2009, in Bernalillo County, in the District of New Mexico, the defendant, **HENRY JAGER**, did knowingly possess a Hewlett Packard Pavillion Desktop Computer, Serial Number 0801S0033121, with a Seagate Internal Hard Disk Drive, Serial Number 6QG3R3AW containing any visual depiction that had
