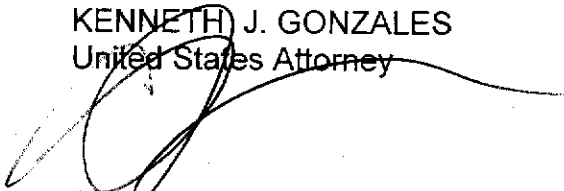
INFORMATION

The United States Attorney charges:

From on or about June 23, 2008, through on or about August 15, 2008, in the District of New Mexico, Defendant **JOSEPH MARVIN HERRERA**, a member and former Governor of the Tesuque Pueblo (the Tribe), did knowingly embezzle, steal and convert to his own use and the use of another, moneys, funds, credits, goods, assets and other property, having a value in excess of \$1,000, that belonged to the Tribe, by making fourteen (14) transfers at ATM machines from the Tribe's account 5737224104 at Wells Fargo Bank into the defendant's own account 0849836457 at Wells Fargo Bank, in the total amount of \$236,000.

In violation of 18 U.S.C. § 1163.
