**MOTION OF THE UNITED STATES TO ESTABLISH BRIEFING
SCHEDULE FOR PROPOSED MODIFICATION OF SECTION II(D)(1)**

The United States has filed a motion, under section VII of the decree, for a modification of section II(D)(1) to permit a trial, supervised by the Department of Justice and the Court, in which Ameritech could provide interexchange service for a limited geographic area, with appropriate safeguards, when competitive local exchange services become available.

The United States respectfully suggests that the Court establish the following schedule for submission of the United States' memorandum and supporting affidavits and for responses and replies by all other decree parties and interested persons:
