Dear Mr. Stallings,


I am writing to request that both Gunnison Energy and SG Interests be prosecuted to the full extent of the law for violating, among others, the Sherman Anti-Trust Act and the Federal Onshore Oil and Gas Leasing Reform Act plus for making false statements all pertaining to the bid-rigging each engaged in surrounding the BLM's oil and gas lease auction that took place on December 19, 2008 in Utah. I also ask that each company's ill-gotten leases be revoked.

The decision requiring the offenders to each pay a \$275,000 fine while permitting each to retain their oil and gas leases and not face any personal consequences is wholly absurd, particularly in light of the overbearing treatment received by Timothy DeChristopher for lesser acts committed during the same auction.

As far as I am concerned, the Justice Department is primed to let down the American people and forsake all that is just and right by choosing to not make an example of these two corporations for their illegal actions. Each conspired to steal land that belonged to me and every other United States citizen and I will not stand for the ridiculously lenient penalty as proposed - this is categorically NOT in the public interest
