

TO APPLY

1. The DEA Intelligence Division is accepting applications and resumes from applicants that must meet the following requirement:

Expert knowledge and specialized intelligence experience. For example, specialized, recurring experience with national and international **law enforcement** and/or intelligence community agencies; obtaining intelligence data and evaluating it; and specialized knowledge of drug intelligence law enforcement.

In addition, applicants must meet one of the following two requirements:

- A. Highly technical state-of-the-art skills associated with computer engineering, systems engineering, and computer science in order to perform and manage highly sensitive and technical special projects.
- B. Foreign language aptitude with proof of certification from an independent outside source with at least a minimum working proficiency level or higher in the areas of reading, writing and comprehension. Applicants must submit proof of certification.

If you believe that you meet the above requirements, please mail your application/resume, inclusive of foreign language certification (if applicable) and any other supporting documentation to the Drug Enforcement Administration, Intelligence Division, Attention: NCM, 8701 Morrisette Drive, Springfield, Virginia 22152. Please note that you will be notified by the DEA of the status of your application as quickly as possible.

For those who do not meet the above requirements, please be advised that, during calendar years 2009 and 2010, DEA will issue announcements for Arlington, VA, Fairfax, VA, Chantilly, VA, the El Paso Intelligence Center and field division offices in Los Angeles, CA; New York, NY; San Diego, CA. and San Francisco, CA; as well as other locations as necessary.
3. As a reminder, should you be selected for a DEA Intelligence Research Specialist position, the DEA does not reimburse applicants for relocation expenses to their first assignment location.
