Order for Presentence Investigation and Disclosure & Sentencing Dates

The defendant having been found guilty on count

, a presentence report is ordered.

- 1. By November 18, 2008 the initial presentence report must be disclosed to counsel (*about 35 days after determination of guilt*).
- 2. By December 2, 2008, counsel must object in writing to the facts used and application of the guidelines or state that there is no objection (14 days after disclosure).
- 3. By December 16, 2008, the probation officer must submit to the judge the final presentence report with an addendum addressing contested issues (14 days after disclosure).
- 4. Sentencing is set for March 3, 2009 at 9:30 a.m. (no sooner than 35 days from initial disclosure).
- 5. For counsel to attend interviews with the defendant, counsel must tell the United States Probation Officer immediately; within 5 days, counsel must supplement that oral request with one in writing.
- 6. The defendant must go immediately—with a copy of this order—to:
