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Introduction

The FY-2010 “Forecast of Contracting Opportunities” is divided loosely into five categories:

1. ADP Equipment and ADP Services Contracts (i.e. Information Technology or IT equipment and IT services contracts.)
2. Construction Contracts
3. Non-Professional Services Contracts (such as guard services, parking services, or courier services, etc.)
4. Professional Services Contracts
5. Supply Contracts

The projected awards may be in any of our nine (9) bureaus. You will notice that most of the anticipated construction awards take place in the Bureau of Prisons.
