If you were convicted during the Vietnam War era of a draft violation and were pardoned by the presidential pardon proclamation of January 21, 1977, you may obtain an individual certificate of pardon showing that the proclamation applies to you **if you can produce the necessary** documentation from your prosecution. If you believe that the proclamation applies to you and wish to obtain such a certificate, complete this application and return it with the required documents to: Office of the Pardon Attorney, 1425 New York Avenue, N.W., Suite 11000, Washington, D.C. 20530. The information you furnish below will be verified. The documents you must provide are: (1) the charging document (the indictment or criminal information) and (2) the judgment of conviction or the court docket sheet showing the sentence and date it was imposed.
