ORDERED that such Proposed Decision be and the same is hereby entered as the Final Decision on this claim, and it is further


ORDERED that the award granted pursuant thereto be certified to the Secretary of the Treasury.

PROPOSED DECISION

This is a claim for \$30,420.00 by Alexander Nicholas Litras, a citizen of the United States since his naturalization on June 18, 1925 at Brooklyn, New York, and is for the damage to real property (a two-story dwelling house) located in Tsoiliou, Kozanis, Greece, and personal property (household fixtures, furnishings and furniture) located in said dwelling house and personal property located in a department store owned and operated by the claimant in Tsoiliou, Kozanis, Greece, as a result of the war in which Italy was engaged

from June 10, 1940 to September 15, 1948.

It is established by the records of the Commission that the claimant was the owner of the real and personal property for which claim is made. It is further established by the record that the damage to the real property and losses of personal property occurred on or about March 28, 1943 as a consequence of military operations in which Italy participated. The Commission finds from the evidence and data before it that the fair and reasonable value of the damage to the real property and losses of personal property was \$8690.79 at the time the loss occurred.

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AWARD

On the above evidence and grounds, this claim is allowed and an award is being made to Alexander Nicholas Litras in the principal amount of \$8,690.79 plus interest in the amount of \$2,642.00 thereon at 6 per cent per annum from March 28, 1943 to April 23, 1948, the date of payment by the Government of Italy of \$5,000,000 pursuant to the Memorandum of Understanding dated August 14, 1947.
