PROPOSED DECISION

This is a claim under the provisions of Section 303 of the International Claims Settlement Act of 1949, as amended, against the Government of Rumania.

Section 306 of the aforesaid Act provides that the Commission shall publish in the Federal Register the time when and the limit of time within which claims may be filed, "which limit shall not be more than one year after such publication, except that with respect to claims under Section 305 this limit shall not exceed six months."

The Commission, in accordance with the Congressional mandate, published its Regulations in the Federal Register on September 30, 1955, designating a one-year period for the filing of claims under Section 303, which period expired at midnight, October 1, 1956. The terminal date for filing claims is a statutory limitation and the Commission has no authority to waive or extend it.


The Commission's records reflect that the claim herein was filed subsequent to October 1, 1956.

Accordingly, the Commission finds that this claim was not timely filed and it is, therefore, denied.
