PROPOSED DECISION

This is a claim under Section 303(3) of the International Claims Settlement Act of 1949, as amended, against the Government of Hungary by FRANK SABO for the failure of the said government to meet its contractual obligations.

The record shows that in 1931 claimant deposited 700 U.S. dollars with the Magyar Leszámitoló és Pénzváltó Bank in Budapest, Hungary.

Information available to the Commission discloses that the said bank maintained a covering account for this deposit with the Chase Manhattan Bank in New York, and that the Chase Manhattan Bank paid in April 1957 the sum of nine hundred thirteen dollars and seventy-seven cents (\$913.77) to claimant in satisfaction of his claim for the deposited seven hundred dollars (\$700.00) and accumulated interest.

Accordingly, this claim is denied for the reason that it has been fully satisfied. The Commission finds it unnecessary to make determinations with respect to other elements of this claim.
