STIPULATED JUDGMENT OF PERMANENT INJUNCTION
AGAINST TAMARA BROCK

The United States has filed a complaint for permanent injunction under Internal Revenue Code (I.R.C.) §§ 7402(a), 7407, and 7408(a) against Tamara Brock. Brock, without admitting the allegations contained in the complaint, hereby consents to the entry, without further notice, of this Stipulated Judgment of Permanent Injunction.

Tamara Brock enters into this Stipulated Judgment of Permanent Injunction voluntarily and waives the entry of findings of fact and conclusions of law. Tamara Brock also waives any right she may have to appeal from this Stipulated Judgment of Permanent Injunction. Tamara Brock further understands and agrees that the Court will retain jurisdiction over this matter for the purpose of implementing and enforcing this order, and Tamara Brock understands that if she violates the order, she may be subject to civil and criminal sanctions for contempt of court.

Tamara Brock consents, without further proceedings, to immediate revocation of all preparer tax identification numbers (PTINs), issued pursuant to 26 U.S.C. § 6109, and she consents to disbarment from practice before the Internal Revenue Service in any capacity. Brock also consents, without further proceedings, to immediate revocation of any Electronic Filing Identification Number (EFIN) held by, assigned to, or used by Tamara Brock.

The parties agree that entry of this Stipulated Judgment of Permanent Injunction resolves only this civil injunction action, and neither precludes the government from pursuing any other current or future civil or criminal matters or proceedings, nor precludes the defendant from contesting her liability in any matter or proceeding.

1. **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Tamara Brock and her representatives, agents, servants, employees and anyone in active concert or participation with her, are PERMANENTLY ENJOINED, pursuant to I.R.C. §§ 7402, 7407, and 7408, effective from entry of this Order from directly or indirectly:

- a. Preparing or filing, or assisting in, or directing the preparation or filing of any federal tax return, amended return, or other federal tax documents or forms for any other person or entity;
- b. Directly or indirectly advising anyone to violate internal revenue laws or unlawfully evade the assessment or collection of their federal tax liabilities, including promoting, selling, or advocating the misuse of false IRS Forms 1040 or other IRS forms;
- c. Filing, providing forms for, or otherwise aiding and abetting the filing of false IRS Forms 1040 or any other IRS forms for herself or others;
- d. Engaging in conduct subject to penalty under I.R.C. §§ 6694 or 6701, including preparing and filing tax returns and other documents that understate the tax liabilities of others;
- e. Preparing her own federal income tax return in a manner that fabricates expenses or purposely understates her own tax liability;
- f. Representing anyone other than herself before the IRS;

2. **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that, pursuant to I.R.C. §§ 7402(a) and 7408, within 15 days of entry of the injunction, Tamara Brock shall provide a copy of this permanent injunction to all customers for whom Brock has provided tax preparation services since January 1, 2011, and Tamara Brock shall provide to counsel for the United States within 30 days a sworn statement, signed under the penalty of perjury, that she has complied with this paragraph.

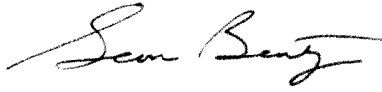
3. **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that, pursuant to I.R.C. §§ 7402(a) and 7408, within 15 days of entry of the injunction, Tamara Brock shall provide a copy of this permanent injunction to principals, officers, managers, representatives, agents, servants, employees, and attorneys of the entities who assisted Brock in providing tax preparation services since January 1, 2011, and Tamara Brock shall provide to counsel for the United States within 30 days a signed and dated acknowledgment of receipt of this Order for each person to whom Tamara Brock provided a copy of this Order in compliance with this paragraph.

4. **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that, pursuant to I.R.C. §§ 7402(a) and 7408, within 15 days of entry of the injunction, Tamara Brock shall provide to the United States a list of all individuals and entities for whom Brock has provided tax preparation services since January 1, 2011.

5. **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the United States may engage in full post-judgment discovery to monitor compliance with the injunction.

6. **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that this Court retains jurisdiction over this action for purposes of implementing and enforcing the final judgment and any additional orders necessary and appropriate to the public interest.

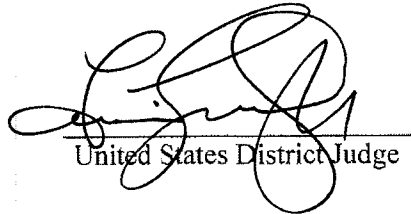
