STIPULATED JUDGMENT OF PERMANENT INJUNCTION

Plaintiff, the United States of America, and defendant, Demita Brown-Watkins ("Brown-Watkins") stipulate as follows:

- 1. The United States commenced this action by filing its Complaint for Permanent Injunction.
- 2. Brown-Watkins consents to the entry of this Stipulated Judgment of Permanent Injunction without further notice and agrees to be bound by its terms.
- 3. This Stipulated Judgment of Permanent Injunction constitutes the final judgment in this action, and Brown-Watkins waives any and all rights to appeal from this judgment.

ORDER

The Court hereby orders:

- A. Under 26 U.S.C. §§ 7402(a), 7407, and 7408, Demita Brown-Watkins is permanently enjoined from, directly or indirectly:
 - i) acting as an income tax return preparer;
 - ii) preparing or filing federal income tax returns, amended returns, and other related documents and forms for others;

- iii) assisting others in the preparation of federal tax returns that she knows will result in the understatement of any tax liability or the overstatement of federal tax refunds;
- iv) engaging in any activity that is subject to penalty under 26 U.S.C. §§ 6694, 6695, or 6701; and
- v) engaging in any fraudulent or deceptive conduct that substantially interferes with the proper enforcement of the internal revenue laws;
- B. The Court will retain jurisdiction to enforce this injunction; and

C. The United States may engage in post-judgment discovery to monitor

Brown-Watkins's compliance with this injunction.
