## **ANCHORAGE MAN SENTENCED TO 41 MONTHS IN FEDERAL PRISON FOR GUN CRIME**

Anchorage, Alaska – United States Attorney Karen L. Loeffler announced that on March 2, 2009, Nathan Karl Bohman, a resident of Anchorage, Alaska, was sentenced in federal court in Anchorage to 41 months for his conviction of being a felon in possession of a firearm. Bohman was convicted by an Anchorage jury in December 2008.

Chief United States District Court Judge John W. Sedwick imposed the sentence on Bohman, age 27.

According to information presented to the court by Special Assistant United States Attorney Kelly Cavanaugh, Bohman was in the middle of the street in a South Anchorage residential neighborhood shooting a firearm at a vehicle. The Anchorage Police Department recovered the firearm used in the shooting along with several other firearms inside Bohman's residence. The State of Alaska Department of Public Safety was able to match shell casings found on the street where Bohman was seen shooting to one of the firearms retrieved from inside Bohman's residence. Bohman was previously convicted of two felony offenses.

Ms. Loeffler commended the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms, and Explosives, the Anchorage Police Department and the Alaska Department of Public Safety for the investigation leading to the successful prosecution of Bohman.
