**SALEM MAN SENTENCED TO 444 MONTHS IN FEDERAL PRISON  
FOR BANK ROBBERIES**

*MONTGOMERY, ALABAMA*— Tony Terrell Moses, Sr., 41, of Salem, Alabama, was sentenced by United States District Judge Myron H. Thompson to serve 444 months in federal prison for bank robbery, U.S. Attorney Leura G. Canary announced today. Moses pled guilty on June 4, 2009, to robbing Five Star Credit Union in Phenix City, Alabama, and Phenix Girard Bank in Smith Station. Moses also pled guilty to possessing a firearm during both bank robberies.

The robbery of the Phenix Girard Bank was investigated by the Lee County Sheriff's Office and FBI Special Agent Stephen McCraney. The Five Star Credit Union robbery was investigated by the Federal Bureau of Investigation and the Phenix City Police Department.

The case was prosecuted by Assistant U.S. Attorney Kent B. Brunson.
