Comes now the Government, and files this Notice of Compliance with this Court’s Order entered on or about July 26, 2013, and states as follows:

1. Individual Notice

Individual notice of this pending action, the rights of the individuals as victims or potential victims and subsequent contact information, was sent by first class mail to those individuals whose names and addresses had been identified by the Government at the time of filing of the Indictment. Those individuals were directed to the appropriate toll free telephone number in order to check on the status of this case and were given contact information to the United States Office of Probation for restitution purposes.

2. Constructive Notice

The following notice was published in the following newspapers as directed by the Court on the dates stated herein:

ATTENTION: FORMER CLIENTS OF COURT MEDIATION SERVICES: The United States Attorney’s Office for the Middle District of Alabama is currently prosecuting a case which alleges, among other things, mail fraud in connection with clients of Court Mediation Services, a company that operated a “Debt Elimination Plan” in Phenix City, Alabama and Columbus, Georgia. This alleged fraud occurred from 2004 through 2011 in the Middle District of Alabama, the Middle District of Georgia,

Springfield, Missouri, and elsewhere. If you were a client of Court Mediation Services during that time and feel that you were a victim of the alleged fraud, you may obtain current information about this case by calling the toll-free Victim Hotline at 1-866-699-0840 or visit our website at www.justice.gov/usao/alm/. An indictment is merely an accusation. A defendant is presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty.
