MAN SENTENCED IN DRUG CASE

MOBILE, Ala. - Vui Van Ho, 54, of Bayou La Batre, Alabama, was sentenced today in federal court. Ho was found guilty by a jury trial in February 2009, and was convicted of possessing with intent to distribute methamphetamine within 1,000 feet of a playground. Judge Kristi Dubose sentenced Ho to 70 months followed by a supervised release term of 3 years.

This case was investigated by the Bayou La Batre Police Department, the Mobile Police Department and the Drug Enforcement Administration. It was prosecuted by Gloria Bedwell in the United States Attorney's Office.
