**MOBILE MAN CHARGED WITH BEING  
A FELON IN POSSESSION OF A FIREARM**

MOBILE, Ala. - **April, 2009**

**One Count Indictment Returned Against a Mobile Man for being a Felon in Possession of a Firearm**

Mack Allen Cowan is charged with being a felon in possession of a firearm after having been convicted of a felony offense. On October 25, 2007, Cowan was convicted of Burglary 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree.

The maximum penalty for a violation of 18 U.S.C. § 922(g)(1), Felon in Possession of a Firearm, is up to 10 years imprisonment and a fine of up to \$250,000.

The case was investigated by the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives. The case is being prosecuted by AUSA Vicki Davis.

An indictment is a determination by a grand jury that there is probable cause to believe that offenses have been committed by a defendant. A defendant, of course, is presumed innocent until and unless he or she is proven guilty at trial.
