LOCAL MAN SENTENCED TO 36 MONTHS FOR ROLL IN FAMILY METHAMPHETAMINE CONSPIRACY

MOBILE, Ala. - David Michael Swindle, age 31, was sentenced to 36 months based on his participation in the illegal manufacture and attempt to manufacture methamphetamine announced Acting United States Attorney for the Southern District of Alabama, Eugene Seidel.

United States District Judge Callie Granade sentenced Swindle to 36 months incarceration for illegal possession of pseudoephedrine in connection to the manufacturing and the attempt to manufacture methamphetamine at the home of his father, Michael Swindle.

This case was investigated by the Drug Enforcement Administration Task Force Agent, Matt O'Brien. The case was prosecuted by Assistant U.S. Attorney Gina S. Vann on behalf of the United States Attorney's Office for the Southern District of Alabama.
