**INDICTMENT RETURNED AGAINST TYLER, TEXAS  
RESIDENT CHARGING POSSESSION OF A FORGED  
ALIEN REGISTRATION RECEIPT CARD**

Mobile, AL - A one-count indictment was returned today by a Federal Grand Jury against Tyler, Texas, resident Juan Castelan-Benitez, charging him with possession of an Alien Registration Receipt Card, also known as a Permanent Resident Card

The Mobile County Sheriff's Office, along with agents with Immigration and Customs Enforcement investigated and presented the case to the U.S. Attorney's Office for prosecution. The prosecutor assigned to the case is Assistant United States Attorney Gloria A. Bedwell.

An indictment is a determination by a grand jury that there is probable cause to believe that offenses have been committed by a defendant. A defendant is presumed innocent until proven guilty.
