**INDICTMENT RETURNED AGAINST FORRESTDAL MAN**  
**CHARGING CONSPIRACY TO POSSESS WITH INTENT**  
**TO DISTRIBUTE CRACK COCAINE**

Mobile, AL - A four-count indictment was returned today by a Federal Grand Jury against Forrestdale, Alabama, resident Thaddeus Cornell Alvis. Count One charged Alvis with conspiracy to possess with intent to distribute crack cocaine. Counts Two and Three charged Alvis with possession with intent to distribute crack cocaine. Count Four alleges forfeiture any property used to commit or facilitate the violations charged in Counts One through Three.

Agents with the Drug Enforcement Administration, along with local law enforcement investigated the case and presented it to the U.S. Attorney's Office for prosecution. The prosecutor assigned to the case is Assistant United States Attorney Gloria A. Bedwell.

An indictment is a determination by a grand jury that there is probable cause to believe that offenses have been committed by a defendant. A defendant is presumed innocent until proven guilty.
