SAN CARLOS MAN SENTENCED TO 30 YEARS IN PRISON FOR SEXUAL ABUSE OF FOUR CHILDREN

PHOENIX – Titus Case, 31, of San Carlos, Ariz., was sentenced today to 30 years in federal prison by U.S. District Judge James A. Teilborg. Case pleaded guilty on June 10, 2009, to three counts of Aggravated Sexual Abuse of a Minor and one count of Abusive Sexual Contact which took place on both the Gila River and San Carlos Indian reservations. The charges involved the sexual abuse of four children under the age of ten.

The investigation in this case was conducted by the Bureau of Indian Affairs and the Gila River Police Department. The prosecution was handled by Dyanne C. Greer, Assistant U.S. Attorney, District of Arizona, Phoenix.
