SCOTTSDALE MAN SENTENCED FOR ASSAULT

PHOENIX – David James Gutierrez, 20, of Scottsdale, Ariz., was sentenced to 52 months in federal prison yesterday by U.S. District Judge Frederick J. Martone. As part of a joint agreement with the Maricopa County Attorney's Office, Gutierrez entered a guilty plea to Aggravated Assault on July 6, 2009. Pursuant to the joint agreement, Gutierrez' sentence will run concurrently with a 180 month sentence imposed in Arizona State Superior Court on unrelated charges.

On January 1, 2008, Gutierrez drove passed the victim's car on the Salt River Pima-Maricopa Indian Reservation. Thinking that someone in the car had shot at him, Gutierrez shot at the victim's car, injuring the victim.

The investigation in this case was conducted by the Salt River Police Department. The prosecution was handled by Thomas C. Simon, Assistant U.S. Attorney, District of Arizona, Phoenix.
