## **NEW PORT RICHEY MAN SENTENCED FOR RECEIPT OF CHILD PORNOGRAPHY**

Tampa, FL - United States District Judge James D. Whittemore yesterday sentenced Walter With (age 64, of New Port Richey) to 72 months in federal prison, to be followed by a life term of supervised release. With had pleaded guilty on January 22, 2009 to one count of receipt of child pornography.

According to court documents, United States Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) agents discovered that With had subscribed to websites featuring child pornography. During the execution of a search warrant at With's home on January 29, 2008, agents discovered that With was in possession of numerous images of child pornography on his computer.

This case was brought as part of Project Safe Childhood, a nationwide initiative launched in May 2006 by the Department of Justice to combat the growing epidemic of child sexual exploitation and abuse. Led by United States Attorneys' Offices and the Criminal Division's Child Exploitation and Obscenity Section (CEOS), Project Safe Childhood marshals federal, state, and local resources to better locate, apprehend, and prosecute individuals who exploit children via the Internet, and as to identify and rescue victims.
