## **ORLANDO MAN GETS NEARLY 50 YEARS FOR CARJACKING**

Orlando, Florida - U.S. Attorney A. Brian Albritton announces that Senior U.S. District Judge Patricia C. Fawsett yesterday sentenced Rohan Oliver Dunn (age 22, of Orlando) to 49 years and 11 months in federal prison for carjacking and using and carrying a firearm during the commission of a crime of violence. The court also ordered Dunn to forfeit items he had used in the commission of his crimes and to pay restitution to his victims. Dunn had pleaded guilty on May 14, 2009 to two counts of carjacking and two counts of using and carrying a firearms during the commission of a crime of violence.

According to court documents, on January 6, 2008, at approximately 1:30 a.m., Dunn and his co-defendant, Damian Jamil Smith, used a 9-millimeter firearm and knife to rob two victims who were walking to their car in a parking garage in downtown Orlando. Dunn and Smith forced their victims into the victims' car and then took the victims to various ATMs where they were forced to withdraw funds from various accounts. Dunn and Smith used the firearm to beat one of the victims. On January 12, 2008, at approximately 10:30 p.m., Dunn and Smith robbed three other people in downtown Orlando. Dunn and Smith again forced their victims to withdraw funds from various bank accounts.

Smith previously pleaded guilty and is scheduled to be sentenced on Monday, September 28, 2009.

This case was investigated by Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms & Explosives (ATF) and the Orlando Police Department. It was prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney Bruce S. Ambrose.
