ST. PETERSBURG CRACK DEALER SENTENCED TO A DECADE IN PRISON

Tampa, FL - U.S. Attorney A. Brian Albritton announces that United States District Judge Virginia Hernandez Covington today sentenced Gregory Robinson (age 26, of St. Petersburg) to 10 years in federal prison. Robinson had pleaded guilty on November 20, 2008 to possessing crack cocaine with the intent to distribute it.

According to court documents, in the summer of 2008, an undercover detective from the St. Petersburg Police Department purchased varying quantities of crack cocaine from Robinson.

This case was investigated by Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms, and Explosives. It was prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney Eduardo Toro-Font of the Tampa Division.
