## **TAMPA MAN SENTENCED AFTER BEING FOUND GUILTY OF WIRE AND FOOD STAMP FRAUD**

Tampa, Florida - U.S. Attorney A. Brian Albritton announces that U.S. District Judge Richard A. Lazzara today sentenced Anton Goubrial (age 47, of Tampa) to six months' home detention and five years' probation for wire fraud in connection with the federal food stamp program. The court also entered a money judgment of \$174,310.95 against Goubrial, for the amount of the proceeds for the fraud.

According to court documents, Goubrial conducted the fraud scheme out of Watson's Food town, a retail convenience store located at 3311 Fifth Avenue North, St. Petersburg. Goubrial had pleaded guilty on April 3, 2009.

This case was investigated by U.S. Secret Service, Florida Department of Law Enforcement, and the United States Department of Agriculture, Office of the Inspector General. It was prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney Terry A. Zitek.
