PALM BAY DRUG DEALER CONVICTED ON DRUG AND GUN CHARGES

Orlando, Florida - U.S. Attorney A. Brian Albritton announced today that a federal jury in Orlando has found Corey Jermaine Parker (age 36, of Palm Bay) guilty of possession with intent to distribute cocaine and using a firearm in relation to a drug trafficking offense. Parker faces a maximum penalty of life in federal prison.

According to evidence presented at trial, Parker ran a drug distribution operation out of his house in a Palm Bay neighborhood. The Palm Bay Police Department executed a search warrant at the house and found an assortment of drugs and a number of weapons, including "AK-47 style" and "AR-15 style" rifles.

This case was investigated by the Drug Enforcement Administration and the Palm Bay Police Department. It was prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney Vincent S. Chiu.
