

I, the undersigned complainant, being duly sworn, state the following is true and correct to the best of my knowledge and belief: On or about June 8, 2009, in Miami-Dade County, in the Southern District of Florida, the defendant, Omar Oneil Lewis, a/k/a "Kevin Omar Ellis," an alien, having previously been removed from the United States was found to be in the United States, knowingly and unlawfully, without the Attorney General or his successor, the Secretary for Homeland Security (Title 6, United States Code, Sections 202(3), 202(4) and 557) having expressly consented to such alien's reapplying for admission to the United States; in violation of Title 8, United States Code, Section 1326(a).

I further state that I am a Special Agent of the Office of Investigations, ICE-DHS, and that this complaint is based on the following facts:

On or about June 8, 2009, Omar Oneil Lewis was brought to the Office of Investigations, U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement, in Miami-Dade County as part of an administrative arrest. After conducting numerous database searches, it was determined that Omar Oneil Lewis was an alien and not a citizen of the United States, but was a native and citizen of Jamaica. Computer records further confirmed that Omar Oneil Lewis was previously removed from the United States on February 23, 2006. A search of the records maintained by the United States Citizenship and Immigration Service also disclosed that Omar Oneil Lewis had never sought to apply for permission from the United States Attorney General or his successor, the Secretary for Homeland Security (Title 6, United States Code, Sections 202(3), 202(4) and 557) in order to return and apply for admission into the United States after having been removed.


