personal, financial and medical information. Having considered the motion, and just cause
having been shown, it is hereby

ORDERED and ADJUDGED as follows:

The motion is GRANTED ~~GRANTED IN PART~~ ~~DENIED~~. It is further

ORDERED and ADJUDGED that discovery provided to the defense by the United States
pursuant to its obligation under the Standing Discovery Order and Federal Rule of Criminal
Procedure 16, which discovery includes customer and victim identification information,
financial information and/or medical information shall be maintained in confidence by defense
counsel and his staff. Such restrictive information includes but is not limited to addresses,

telephone numbers, account numbers, credit reports, height, weight, illnesses and treatments. It is further

ORDERED and ADJUDGED that such information provided to the defense shall not be disclosed to the defendant or disclosed in a non redacted format in any public pleading. It is further

ORDERED and ADJUDGED that following the completion of this matter such records shall be returned to the United States Attorney's Office or the defendant's counsel shall advise this Court by a pleading that such records have been destroyed.
