As you are by now aware, we have indicted the above defendants in connection with the fraudulent sale of Lipoban dietary supplement. You are a witness in the case and have probably received the initial letter and progress report explaining your rights as a witness.

This letter is an updated progress report about the case. The trial is now scheduled to commence on February 9, 2009. You will be notified about making travel arrangements (at government expense) to West Palm Beach as the case gets closer to trial.

Although not yet finalized, Defendant Forgione has announced at a calendar call that he intends to plead guilty and cooperate with the government in exchange for a reduced sentence. It is anticipated, although not finalized, that he will be pleading guilty to counts with a maximum term of 10 years in jail.
