The Grand Jury charges that:

**COUNT 1**

**CONSPIRACY TO PRODUCE CHILD PORNOGRAPHY**

Beginning at an unknown time in 2012, and continuing to on or about January 5, 2013, within the Eastern District of Louisiana and elsewhere, the defendant, **VITTORIO FRANCESCO GONZALEZ-CASTILLO** and another person known to the grand jury, did knowingly conspire to employ, use, persuade, induce, entice, and coerce a minor victim to engage in sexually explicit conduct for the purpose of producing any visual depiction of such

conduct using materials that have been mailed, shipped, and transported in and affecting interstate and foreign commerce by any means, including by computer.

All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 2251(a) and (e).

**NOTICE OF FORFEITURE**

1. The allegations of Count 1 of this Indictment are realleged and incorporated by reference as though set forth fully herein for the purpose of alleging forfeiture to the United States of America pursuant to the provisions of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2253.
2. As a result of the offenses alleged in Count 1, defendant, **VITTORIO FRANCESCO GONZALEZ-CASTILLO**, shall forfeit to the United States all property, real or personal, constituting or traceable to gross profits or other proceeds obtained from such offenses; and/or any property, real or personal, used or intended to be used to commit or to promote the commission of such offenses, in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 2251(a) and (e), and 2253.
3. If any of the property described above as being subject to forfeiture, as a result of any act or omission of the defendant:
  - a. cannot be located upon the exercise of due diligence;
  - b. has been transferred or sold to, or deposited with, a third person;
  - c. has been placed beyond the jurisdiction of the Court;
  - d. has been substantially diminished in value; or
  - e. has been commingled with other property which cannot be subdivided without difficulty;


