**COUNT 1**

**(Possession of Child Pornography)**

Beginning at a time unknown and continuing until on or about October 4, 2004, within the Eastern District of Louisiana, and elsewhere, **RALPH ROBERTS**, defendant herein, did knowingly possess one or more matters, that is, a computer hard drive, disks, and computer media containing digital images, computer images, and digital video files, which contained visual depictions that had been mailed, shipped, and transported in interstate and foreign commerce, and which were produced using materials which have been mailed, shipped, and transported in interstate and foreign commerce, by any means including by computer, the production of which involved the use of a minor engaging in sexually explicit conduct, as defined in Title 18, United States Code, Section 2256(2), and such visual depictions were of such conduct.

All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2252(a)(4)(B).




**FORFEITURE ALLEGATION**


1. The allegations of this Bill of Information are re-alleged as if fully set forth here, for the purpose of alleging forfeiture, pursuant to Title 18, United States Code, Section 2253.


2. If convicted of the offense or offenses set forth above, **RALPH ROBERTS**, the defendant herein, shall forfeit to the United States any and all materials and property used and intended to be used in the receipt and possession of visual depictions of minors engaging in sexually explicit conduct, and any and all property, real or personal, constituting or traceable to gross profits or other proceeds obtained from the offense. Such property includes, but is not limited to, the following specific items found by federal agents on or about October 4, 2004:

1. Gateway personal computer;
