**FACTUAL BASIS**

Were this matter brought to trial the United States would prove, through competent witnesses and documentary evidence, the following beyond a reasonable doubt.

During May 2008, in the Eastern District of Louisiana, the defendant, **WILLIAM E. BOONE**, was employed as a full-time custodian for the United States Postal Service. On May 22, 2008, **BOONE** possessed the contents of a package addressed to John Beaton, General Delivery, Lake Forest Station, 9600 Lake Forest Boulevard, New Orleans, Louisiana, 70127; namely one Nokia brand cellular phone, serial number IMEI: 357654/01/224505/9, and one cellular phone electric charger. As a custodian for the United States Postal Service, **BOONE** had lawfully come into possession of the package and its contents, which was intended to be conveyed by

mail. **BOONE** then embezzled the package and its contents, that is, he wrongfully and intentionally took items in the package addressed to John Beaton. United States Postal Inspectors estimate the known loss resulting from defendant's misconduct is \$585.00.

After being advised of his constitutional rights, **BOONE** admitted the foregoing facts to inspectors of the United States Postal Inspection Service.
