The Grand Jury charges that:

COUNT 1

**A.   AT ALL TIMES MATERIAL HEREIN:**

1.     “A.R.” and “T.L.”, the identities of whom are known by the Grand Jury, were students at Nicholls State University in Thibodaux, Louisiana.
2.     The defendant, **DYRON L. HART**, was a former student at Nicholls State University.
3.     The defendant, **DYRON L. HART**, used a fictitious name and photograph when he transmitted the threats identified hereinbelow.

**B.   THE THREAT:**

On or about November 5, 2008, in the Eastern District of Louisiana, the defendant, **DYRON L. HART**, did knowingly and intentionally transmit in interstate commerce from

Poplarville, Mississippi, to the State of Louisiana, a communication over the internet to “A.R.” and others, and the communication contained a threat to injure and kill “A.R.” and others, in that the defendant, **DYRON L. HART**, sent a message through the internet website “Facebook” threatening to kill “A.R.” and others; all in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 875(c).

**COUNT 2**

**A. AT ALL TIMES MATERIAL HEREIN:**

1. The allegations contained in Count 1, Paragraph A, are realleged and incorporated as though fully set forth herein.

**B. THE THREAT:**




