FEDERAL GUN LAWS

PROHIBIT YOU FROM

Possessing a gun if you've been convicted of assaulting:

your child;

your spouse or live-in partner (past or present); orthe mother or father of your child.

18 U.S.C. § 922(g)(9)

 Possessing a gun if you are subject to a final protection from abuse order.

18 U.S.C. § 922(g)(8)

Possessing a gun if you are a convicted felon.

18 U.S.C. § 922(g)(1)

Providing a handgun to anyone under age 18.

18 U.S.C. § 922(x)

Buying a gun for someone who is prohibited from owning a gun.

18 U.S.C. § 922(a)(6) and 922(d)

Selling a gun to someone who lives out of state.

18 U.S.C. § 922(a)(5)

Lying on an application to buy a gun.

18 U.S.C. § 922(a)(6)
