**Canadian Man Pleads Guilty to Federal Drug Charges**

Bangor, Maine: United States Attorney Paula D. Silsby announced that **Matthew Stanley**, 25, of Campobello, New Brunswick, Canada, pled guilty on May 4, 2009, in U.S. District Court in Bangor, Maine, to unlawful distribution of Oxycontin. Stanley was taken into custody at the time of his plea and is awaiting sentencing. He faces a possible sentence of up to 20 years and a fine of not more than \$1,000,000, or both.

Court records reveal that in September 2008, through undercover police work conducted by U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement and the Maine Drug Enforcement Agency, it was learned that Stanley was selling Oxycontin in the Washington County area. Later in the same month, Stanley sold Oxycontin to an undercover police officer.

United States Attorney Silsby praised the investigation conducted by the U.S. Department of Homeland Security, Immigration and Customs Enforcement and the Maine Drug Enforcement Agency.
