Massachusetts Man Receives 10+ Year Federal Sentence

Portland, Maine: United States Attorney Paula D. Silsby announced today that **Jose Reynoso**, 43, of Lawrence, Massachusetts, was sentenced on May 5, 2009, in U.S. District Court to 125 months in prison and five years of supervised release for his role in trafficking cocaine, crack cocaine, and heroin. U.S. District Court Judge D. Brock Hornby imposed the sentence following Reynoso's guilty plea entered on November 24, 2008.

Court documents indicate that Reynoso was involved with the distribution of illegal drugs in Massachusetts and Maine for multiple months in 2007. Law enforcement learned that Reynoso was the source of supply for 19.7 grams of crack cocaine and 9.7 grams of heroin intercepted by agents with the United States Drug Enforcement Administration in Biddeford, Maine on December 6, 2007.

U.S. Attorney Silsby praised the investigative efforts of the United States Drug Enforcement Administration. U.S. Attorney Silsby also recognized the contributions of the Lawrence, Massachusetts Police Department.
