**Canadian Man Sentenced on Federal Drug Charges**

Bangor, Maine: United States Attorney Paula D. Silsby announced that **Matthew Stanley**, 26, of Campobello, New Brunswick, Canada, was sentenced on November 2, 2009, in U.S. District Court in Bangor, Maine, to 12 months imprisonment, 3 years supervised release, and a special assessment of \$100, for unlawful distribution of Oxycontin. Stanley pled guilty on May 4, 2009.

Court records reveal that in September 2008, through undercover police work conducted by U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement and the Maine Drug Enforcement Agency, it was learned that Stanley was selling Oxycontin in the Washington County area. Later in the same month, Stanley sold Oxycontin to an undercover police officer on three occasions.

United States Attorney Silsby praised the investigation conducted by the U.S. Department of Homeland Security, Immigration and Customs Enforcement and the Maine Drug Enforcement Agency.
