THE UNITED STATES GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

COUNT 1
(Unlawful Re-entry After Removal)

On or about November 5, 2011, in the State and District of Minnesota, the defendant,

JOEL AGUAYO-GOMEZ,

an alien who had previously been removed from the United States on or March 30, 2011, subsequent to a conviction for an aggravated felony, namely, Aggravated Robbery in the First Degree, in Ramsey County, Minnesota in 2008, knowingly and unlawfully re-entered and was found in the United States without having obtained the consent of the Attorney General of the United States or his successor, the Secretary for Homeland Security, to re-apply for admission into the United States, all in violation of Title 6, United States Code, Sections 202(3), 202(4), and 557, and Title 8, United States Code, Sections 1326(a) and 1326(b)(2).
