THE UNITED STATES GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

COUNT 1

(Unlawful Re-Entry After Removal)

On or about May 1, 2013, in the State and District of Minnesota, the defendant,

JUAN MANUEL CONTRERAS-LEPE,
a/k/a Ezekiel Hernandez-Sandoval,

an alien who had previously been removed from the United States on or about August 22, 2000, subsequent to a conviction for an aggravated felony, namely, a conviction on or about July 6, 1995, in the 6th Circuit Court in Dade City, Florida, for felony aggravated battery, did knowingly and unlawfully re-enter and was found in the United States without having obtained the consent of the Attorney General of the United States, or his successor, the Secretary of Homeland Security, to re-apply for admission into the United States, in violation of Title 8, United States Code, Section 1326(a)(1) and (b)(2), and Title 6, United States Code, Sections 202 and 557.
