THE UNITED STATES GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

COUNT 1
(Illegal Re-entry After Deportation)

On or about March 7, 2013, in the State and District of Minnesota, the defendant,

HECTOR RAUL ESTRADA-GARCIA,

an alien who had previously been deported from the United States on or about May 4, 2000, subsequent to a conviction for an aggravated felony, namely, a conviction on or about April 22, 1997, in the United States District Court for the District of Minnesota, for distribution of methamphetamine, knowingly and unlawfully entered and was found in the United States without having obtained the consent of the Attorney General of the United States, or his successor, the Secretary of Homeland Security, to re-apply for admission into the United States in violation of Title 8, United States Code, Sections 1326(a) and 1326(b)(2) and Title 6, United States Code, Sections 202 and 557.
