THE UNITED STATES GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

COUNT 1

(Illegal Re-entry After Removal)

On or about April 10, 2013, in the State and District of Minnesota, the defendant,

EDUARDO GALLARDO-GUTIERREZ,
a/k/a Carlos Meza,

an alien who had previously been removed from the United States on or about March 10, 2004, subsequent to a conviction for an aggravated felony, namely, a conviction on or about September 24, 1998, in Tama County District Court, in the State of Iowa, for Burglary in the Third Degree, knowingly and unlawfully entered and was found in the United States without having obtained the consent of the Attorney General of the United States, or his successor, the Secretary of Homeland Security, to re-apply for admission into the United States, in violation of Title 8, United States Code, Sections 1326(a) and 1326(b)(2), and Title 6, United States Code, Sections 202 and 557.
