THE UNITED STATES GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

COUNT 1
(Illegal Re-entry After Deportation)

On or about April 30, 2013, in the State and District of Minnesota, the defendant,

VICTOR ERNESTO HERNANDEZ-NAVAEZ,

an alien who had previously been deported from the United States on or about December 21, 2007, subsequent to a conviction for an aggravated felony, namely, a conviction on or about October 9, 2001, in Ramsey County, Minnesota, for Possession of a Controlled Substance With Intent to Distribute, knowingly and unlawfully entered and was found in the United States without having obtained the consent of the Attorney General of the United States, or his successor, the Secretary of Homeland Security, to re-apply for admission into the United States, in violation of Title 8, United States Code, Sections 1326(a)(1) and 1326(b)(2), and Title 6, United States Code, Sections 202 and 557.
