COUNT 1
(Assault Resulting in Serious Bodily Injury)

On or about August 30, 2013, in the State and District of Minnesota, and within the exterior boundaries of the Red Lake Indian Reservation, the defendant,

an Indian, did assault Baby Doe, also an Indian and an individual who had not attained the age of 18 years, resulting in serious bodily injury, in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 113(a)(6), 1151, 1153(a), and 3559(f)(3).
