COUNT 1

(Illegal Re-entry After Removal)

On or about May 11, 2013, in the State and District of Minnesota, the defendant,

JOSE ISRAEL GUTIERREZ-GARCIA,

an alien who had previously been removed from the United States on or about November 21, 2012, subsequent to a conviction for a felony, namely, a conviction on or about March 28, 2008, in Hennepin County Minnesota, for First Degree Driving While Impaired, and a conviction on or about November 6, 2012, in Dakota County Minnesota, for Drugs-5th Degree Possession, knowingly and unlawfully entered and was found in the United States without having obtained the consent of the Attorney General of the United States, or his successor, the Secretary of Homeland Security, to re-apply for admission into the United States, in violation of Title 8, United States Code, Sections 1326(a) and 1326(b)(1), and Title 6, United States Code, Sections 202 and 557.
