did knowingly and unlawfully possess, in and affecting interstate commerce, a firearm, that is, a Taurus, .22 caliber semi-automatic handgun, model PT-22, bearing serial number AYI39754, in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 922(g)(1) and 924(a)(2).

FORFEITURE ALLEGATION

If convicted of Count 1 of this Indictment, the defendant shall forfeit to the United States any firearms, accessories and ammunition involved in or used in connection with such violations including, but not limited to a Taurus, .22 caliber semi-automatic handgun, model PT-22, bearing serial number AYI39754, and ammunition, pursuant to Title 18, United States Code, Section 924(d)(1), and Title 28, United States Code, Section 2461(c).
