THE UNITED STATES GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

**COUNT 1**

(Illegal Reentry After Removal)

On or about May 7, 2013, in the State and District of Minnesota, the defendant,

**ALFREDO RIOS-GUZMAN,**

an alien who had previously been removed from the United States on or about November 14, 2007, subsequent to a conviction for an aggravated felony, namely, a conviction on or about October 30, 2007, in Hennepin County District Court, in the State of Minnesota, for Assault in the Second Degree with a dangerous weapon, knowingly and unlawfully entered and was found in the United States without having obtained the consent of the Attorney General of the United States, or his successor, the Secretary of Homeland Security, to apply for admission into the United States, in violation of Title 8, United States Code, Sections 1326(a) and 1326(b)(2), and Title 6, United States Code, Sections 202 and 557.
