THE UNITED STATES GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

COUNT 1

(Felon in Possession of a Firearm)

On or about July 18, 2007, in the State and District of Minnesota, the defendant,

TYRONE SHADALE OAKS,

having previously been convicted of at least three separate violent felonies each punishable by imprisonment for a term exceeding one year, to wit:

As a result of the foregoing offense, the defendant,

TYRONE SHADALE OAKS,

shall forfeit to the United States pursuant to Title 18, United States Code, Section 924(d)(1), all his right, title and interest in any firearm or ammunition involved in or used in any knowing violation of Sections 922(g)(1) and 924(a)(2), including a Helwan, 9 mm caliber, semiautomatic pistol, serial number 1978. All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 922(g)(1), and

924(d)(1), in conjunction with Title 28, United States Code,
Section 2461(c).
